Interview and Seating of new council member Rebecca Lopez. Questions and answers followed. Patrick moved to accept the application, Discussion followed, Barb seconded, all approved.

AIA: James Bush and Karen McCall- She's a 21 yr. veteran with the WA. State Liquor Control Board. An AIA has to be in a specific area with in a city or county. Citizens have to make a constant log and write the time, day, and brand of every beer or wine bottle or can they find. They also need to write the ounces. We need crime stats, detox admissions, detox reports, etc. We also need 6mo volunteer efforts from the stores to work with us. If we don't get compliance, then we go back to the council and tell them to take it to the

liquor control board to adopt the AIA. It can take 3-6 months for the decision. It's effective immediately and they usually give the stores 45 days they can get ride of the inventory. More products can be added every 3 months as they come out. The AIA will remain in effect for 2 years and the local jurisdiction would have to write the liquor control board to get it removed. Annexation will have no effect on an AIA. The process of a liquor license is 20 days and in an AIA area it's 90 days. Stats and information was handed out.

Questions and answers followed.

Jeff Hancock: On Roxbury between 14th and 18th there are 4-5 businesses that sell single bottles or cans of alcohol. There are people sleeping and passed out at bus stops. There is lots of call regarding intoxicated people.

New Business: KC Sheriff's Office Storefront: Heidi would like a letter written to Dow and Ron Sims about keeping the storefronts open. Discussion followed. Barb motion Heidi to write the letter and every council member to do the same. Heidi will e-mail everyone with the contact information. James will also pass along what we discussed and will get back to us at the next meeting.

Next discussion will be on the map and the areas we are looking at for the AIA. Everyone needs to start their documentation. Further discussion will follow and KCSO will be involved.

New Bar in White Center- Ron wants to know how we can be notified about new liquor licenses.

Old Business: Report graffiti on the website. Barb got paint from McLendon's – 8or9 5 gallons and about 50 1-quart sizes.

SC Fundraiser-Auction items are coming in. Donates needed for the silent auction. Invitations and inserts are ready. We each need to get 12 people to purchase tickets. Barb announced the table captain's- Bong, Barb, Pam, Patti, Rose, Gary, Christine, Pat Price, Joann, and Heidi. St. Bernadette's will help serve for \$100.00 and its \$250.00 for the custodian. We have to have special insurance so we are partnering up with the North Highline Fire Dept. who will carry the insurance.
